Content and care information, if appropriate.
☐ If your work has not sold after 60 days, you will be asked to pick it up from the SEFAA Center. (Larger items at higher price points may be considered for longer at SEFAA's discretion.) Items unclaimed after 90 days will become the property of SEFAA.

A description of the item(s) you are interested in selling. For each item, include:Type and general size (queen-sized quilt, earrings,)
☐ Number (how many do you have to sell)
☐ Materials (natural, synthetic)

☐ You must email representative images of the work you'd like to sell to
info@fiberartsalliance.org within one week of submitting your application. If your images do not clearly convey quality, size, or other necessary information, you can bring your work to the SEFAA Center to be evaluated.
